
Laws and Issuances related to Petroleum Exploration

- Presidential Decree 87
 - Oil Exploration and Development Act of 1972
 - Provides the legal basis for the exploration and development of indigenous petroleum resources authorizing the grant of SERVICE CONTRACTS entered into thru public bidding or through negotiations.
- DOE Circular DC-2006-12-0014
 - Reiterating a transparent and competitive systems of awarding service contracts for coal, geothermal and petroleum prospective areas

Some concerns in data quality, integrity and security

Current DBMS is outdated

Future Plans to improve database management

Upgrading of existing database management system to include the following functionalities:

- Acquisition of additional hardware' and software'
- Conversion of 9 inches seismic survey reel tapes to more compact storage media
- Conversion of paper maps/charts, reports and seismic sections to digital data
- Web-based or remote data and information access
- Remote data collection/update of attribute databases
- Centralized storage and backup of statistical data

Recommendations

- Adopt the CCOP natural gas metadata design & structure
- Data quality, integrity and security should be one of the priorities in oil and gas database management
- The acquired knowledge in the CCOP Metadata workshops should be reported and proposed implementation work plans be recommended to our top management
