


Concession System

Thailand's Petroleum Concession (As Jan,09)




Total 62 concessions 80 blocks


Discoveries of petroleum resources have been one of the major factors contributing to Thailand's Economy in the past decades.



Petroleum Production in Thailand (1981-2008)






Section 76 - The concessionaire shall submit report and results of his petroleum operations to the Department of Mineral Fuels


- The reports and results shall be treated as confidential and shall not be disclosed for a certain period from the date DMF received or deemed in receipt of the reports and results, except
 - disclosure is to be made in the performance of the Government's service to the government agencies or persons who have duties to perform in accordance with the laws or with the Government's regulations
 - disclosure is the making use of information in preparing and publishing scientific, technical or statistical or records with a prior approval of the Director-General – however, disclosure of commercial information shall be avoided to the utmost extent
 - a prior written consent; and to such disclosure the concessionaire shall give without delay his consent or dissent


