<b>Sponsorship</b>	<p><b>Daily Subsistence Allowance (DSA):</b> will be distributed to sponsored participants at registration on 5 September from 8:30-9:00 am. This DSA covers accommodation (based on single occupancy rate), meals and any incidental expenses. Sponsored participants are to settle the payment of their room and personal expenses with the hotel directly. In case of compulsory overnight transit, the cost of extra nights will also be calculated into the DSA and assistance can be provided for hotel reservation.</p> <p><b>Air-tickets:</b> Sponsored participants are kindly requested to purchase the air-ticket for reimbursement upon the provision of original receipt indicating CCOP-approved airfare.</p>
